
LET YOUR MONEY FIGHT



Fighting with money: Patriotism, Thrift and Warfare in the British World, 1939-1950

HRC Work in Progress Seminar with Professor Carol Summers, University of Richmond During and immediately after WWII, propaganda educated British subjects around the world to consider their money as a weapon. Fighting with money, campaigners asserted, was patriotic, would win the war and lay the foundation for a new world. This project examines the propaganda and practices of this global thrift and savings initiative, examining agency and possibility within an embattled, austere, and faltering empire seeking survival and repair in a radically changing world.

Carol Summers is Professor of History at the University of Richmond, where she teaches African and comparative history.
